

Free afternoon - Recommendations

Friday, August 2

1. Main Square of San Miguel de Allende

In the center of town, is El Jardín Allende, better known as the Main Square of San Miguel de Allende. In this space there are children, adults, tourists and locals to enjoy the baroque architecture of the buildings that are around. During the year many of the activities of the town take place in this garden that is the protagonist of one of the most beautiful spaces of the town.

2. "La Esquina" Mexican Popular Toy Museum

If you like Mexican traditions, you should visit "La Esquina" Mexican Folk Toy Museum. The museum has more than 3,000 toys collected over 50 years. It is open to the public from Saturday to Sunday and there are special costs for children and school groups.

3. San Miguel Adventure Park

It is 10 minutes from the town. It has zip line, suspension bridge, ATV and trekking. There is even the option of camping for the most risky. The park offers activities that will fill you with adrenaline and boost your visit.

4. Aerostatic Balloons

If the extreme is not your thing, perhaps a hot air balloon trip might work for you. Fly in Globe, it will change the way you will see San Miguel de Allende. From the height, these walks of 45 minutes to an hour are excellent to start the day. Trips begin at 06:00 am and include breakfast and toast.

5. Coyote Canyon Adventures

The outdoor activities are the protagonists of this magical town. An experience that will completely change your trip are the Rides of Night Riding. Coyote Canyon Adventures offers family outings with breakfast and dinner included. The excursion may include camping and the costs include equipment for the night.

6. Rancho Xolotar

7. The Spa Grotto

After hiking, a good option to relax are the thermal waters of La Gruta SPA. They have a very ecological philosophy, so they work with natural products. Their packages of massages and relaxing treatments are among the best in the area.

8. Paseo del Chorro and Lavaderos

For sightseeing and history, the Paseo del Chorro and Lavaderos is a good option. Legend has it that in those lands Friar Juan de San Miguel found a spring and decided to found the city in those spaces. It is located in the Paseo del Chorro. They give morning walks and the possibility of picnics in the area.

9. The Church of Our Lady of Health

It comes out completely of the traditional church stereotype. In its infrastructure they show cheerful images and a very pleasant aesthetic. It is located in Juarez esq. Mesones, Centro, and is ideal for parishioners and art lovers.

10. Angela Peralta Theater

If you want to see a work in your visit, you can go to the Angela Peralta Theater. Founded in 1873, this theater has a history and space where works that entertain the whole community are constantly presented.

11. Restaurant María y su Bici
