Description

This city was founded in 1542 by the missionary Juan de San Miguel who gave it the name of San Miguel el Grande in honor of his devotion to the Archangel Michael. Already for the year 1826 and in honor of one of the most renowned heroes of the independence war "Ignacio Allende" the city takes its current name of San Miguel Allende.



San Miguel de Allende is one of the few cities whose architecture has been conserved, it seems that time stopped to preserve its monuments. Touring its cobbled streets, tourists can see countless art galleries, museums, convents and churches, and colonial-style mansions.

How to get there?

The International Airport of Mexico City, 294 km away, receives international flights from anywhere in the world.


Guanajuato, also known as Bajío Airport, located in the city of Silao, 138 km away, receives flights from Aeromexico, United, Delta and American Airlines from Chicago, Dallas, Houston, Los Angeles, Las Vegas and Atlanta.

Queretaro Airport (QRO) located 69 km away, which also serves international flights.

* Ground transportation will be provided from Mexico City airport to San Miguel de Allende on Tuesday, July 30, in three different schedules which we will share as soon as possible.

Weather

Its average temperature ranges between 16 ° C and 22 ° C. The predominant climate in the municipality is dry-temperate, with moderately warm and rainy summers, while winters are cool.



The rainy season begins in June and lasts until mid-October.

- ✓ Visit the parish of San Miguel Arcángel, symbol of the city, founded at the end of the 17th century.
- ✓ Behind the “Parroquia de San Miguel” is Posada Corazón, a very good option for breakfast; right on Calle Aldama 9.
- ✓ Do not forget to go for your churros and hot chocolate at Margarita Gralia's coffee.
- ✓ If you want to eat with good live jazz, take a walk around the Tío Lucas restaurant.
- ✓ The Aurora Factory is 15 minutes from downtown, there are galleries of local artists and divine stores.
- ✓ Bring comfortable shoes to walk, everything can be known on foot!
- ✓ Most of the year San Miguel de Allende has a good temperate climate. You can bring your swimsuit to use in the hotels pool, but do not forget to pack a sweater for the night.
- ✓ Take a tour of the Handicraft Market and the Walker Lucas Balderas, acquire handicrafts in brass and natural sheet.
- ✓ Meet the former Municipal Palace, built in 1736; This is where the first independent Mexico City Council was installed in 1810.
- ✓ Take a picture in the main square.
- ✓ Delight yourself with original cuisine.
- ✓ San Miguel de Allende is a beautiful city, but because a lot of foreign tourists arrive, the prices are a little higher than in other parts of Guanajuato.
